PRIVATE PRACTICE

Although we work out of the facility at the Granada centre at St John of God (SJOG), Halswell, and work

closely with the allied health team there, we are a private practice and work as independent contractors. Our fees reflect that which is necessary to provide a high quality music therapy service. This includes preparation/planning, documentation, purchase and maintenance of resources, equipment and instruments, business overheads (Levies, phone, transport, insurance), general administration, venue hire, supervision and professional development.

We do our best to make this fee as fair as possible. Please remember that we work an average of 46 weeks of the year so please calculate this into your budget.
